Selection Process:

Applications are available at the Extension website: https://www.extension.iastate.edu/clarke

Applications will only be accepted electronically in PDF form please. The electronic applications are due by March 1st, 2023. Please attach letters of recommendations to the PDF. The electronic submissions may be made to clarke4h@iastate.edu or mcarl@iastate.edu. Email confirmations will be returned.

Applications will be reviewed by the 4-H Foundation Committee to determine which applicants are eligible and winners will be selected. Scholarship winners will be recognized during the Clarke County Fair.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 4-H'er must have been a member of a Clarke County 4-H club for five years, including their Jr. & Sr. years in high school.
- 4-H'er must have exhibited at the Clarke County Fair.
- 4-H'er must have participated in a community service project.
- 4-H'er must submit a 4-H Scholarship Application.
- 4-H'er must submit two letters of recommendation along with the application. One letter of recommendation must be from a 4-H leader. The second may be from any non-family member of your choice.
