## IOWA STATE RIFLE & PISTOL ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

#### General

- a. The Iowa State Rifle & Pistol Assn. (ISRPA) offers 2-\$1000 one-year scholarships on the basis of merit to selected high school seniors who are currently enrolled in a team or club that is participating in Rifle Pistol Air Rifle or Shotgun competitions. The ISRPA seeks applications from high school seniors who currently compete in markmanship competitions.
- b. ISRPA Scholarships may be used to pursue a post-secondary education during the upcoming school year. Scholarships are one-year awards that may be used to fund any accredited post-secondary education or vocational program.
- c. Scholarship recipients must have a 3.0 GPA, plan to continue to excel in rifle air rifle pistol or shotgun team activities, and continue to meet other scholarship eligibility criteria.
- d. Scholarship checks are paid jointly to the scholarship recipient and the financial aid office of the college or university where the student enrolls.

#### **Nomination Eligibility:**

High School Seniors selected for these scholarships must:

- a. Be a U.S. Citizen.
- b. Be of good moral character.
- c. Have achieved a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- d. Be a graduating high school senior.
- e. Demonstrates acceptance to a university, college or trade school leading to a diploma or trade certification.
- f. Demonstrate Rifle-Air Rifle-Pistol-Shotgun marksmanship competition experience.

#### **Application**

- a. Applicants must complete the Iowa State Rifle & Pistol Assn. Application Form. Copies of the application form can be requested from the Secretary at billb@iasrpa.org.
- b. The application forms are to be completed and postmarked no later than MARCH 1. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

#### **Final Selection and Acceptance**

- a. All applications must be sent to: ISRPA SECRETARY 240 PROSPECT RD, NORTH LIBERTY, IA 52317 Attn. Scholarships. Applications must be **postmarked** no later than MARCH 1.
- b. Applicants will be notified by APRIL 30.

#### **Notification:**

- a. ISRPA will notify successful applicants and their school of the award by APRIL 30. Results will be also posted on the ISRPA website.
- b. Scholarships recipients must respond by returning the confirmation form by July 1<sup>st</sup> to confirm that they accept the scholarship and to provide contact information for the College, University or vocational school where they will enroll. The Scholarship Check will be forwarded to the College, University or vocational school.

#### **Completed Applications:**

A complete application must contain all required documentation please include:

- a. A completed Scholarship Application Form.
- b. A certified copy of the applicant's high school transcript.
- c. Letter of Nomination from the Coach, Instructor or Adult Leader.
- d. Letter of Recommendation. (Other then the writer of the nomination)
- e. A letter from the applicant including the reasons for applying and how the scholarship will help in pursuit of the applicant's goals.
- f. Documentation of markmanship activity.
